



Has Monroe County School District forced your child with a disability to stay home or away from the standard classroom?

What is happening?


The Department of Education found that Monroe County School District is **violating the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)**. The district is:


1. **placing students with disabilities in overly restrictive settings**, typically at home and with shortened school days, limiting access to their regular learning setting, and
2. **misusing a process called the 45-day interim alternate education setting (IAES) process**, removing students with disabilities inappropriately instead of creating more educational placement options.

Disability Rights Florida is concerned that these violations of the IDEA are continuing in Monroe County.
